### So, what's the point of SharePoint?

SharePoint is a 'website' of sorts that the English Department has built to help students prepare for GCSEs in both English Language and Literature. The idea is that students gain some independent study and have an easy access hub to some really important and useful information, including past papers, worksheets, exam information, and much more.

There are a number of ways that your child can access it:

First of all, they can follow either of these two links:

They will be prompted to insert their username and password credentials, an example of which is below:

Their email address is 'mbs012345@meole.co.uk'

Their password is the *same* password that they use to logon to any of the computers at school.

If they have already installed either the *Outlook* app on their phone or tablet, then they can go one better by installing the *SharePoint* app. They can do this by QR scanning one of the two relevant codes at the bottom of this flier.

The SharePoint will be constantly updated with resources. Students will find news articles, key dates, quizzes and polls, and much more. We hope students will get the most of this as a system. If they do not have internet access then the Library is open before and after school and during both breaks.
