

How to Structure Sentences Effectively For students *Five Golden Rules: -*

- 1. Sentences **must** always begin with a capital letter.
- 2. Sentences **must** always end with. (Or ... Or ? Or !)
- 3. Sentence **must** make sense. Check through them to make sure they say exactly what you want them to and you have not missed out any words.
- 4. Two sentences can be linked together using connectives such as *'next'*, *'in addition' or 'on the other hand'*.
- Usually sentences follow an SVO (subject verb object) pattern in English. For example, 'The teacher walked down the corridor.'
