<p>Conflict and Reconciliation <i>Understanding how to maturely respond to relationship fall outs and break ups.</i></p>	<p>Sexting <i>Looking at the laws of sexting and how to deal with indecent requests.</i></p>	<p>Sex and Health (STIs) <i>Getting to grips with the various STI's and how they are caught, dealt with and their symptoms.</i></p>	<p>LGBTQ+ - Pride <i>Looking at what the acronym stands for – a focus on transgender and non binary.</i></p>
<p>Family and Conflict <i>Understanding the different types of families and using past learning to deal with a family conflict scenario.</i></p>	<p>Positive Relationships <i>The different types of relationships and recapping on healthy behaviours.</i></p>	<p>Diversity within intimate relationships <i>Looking at various different relationships – same sex, people of different beliefs and cultural backgrounds, as well as between people who do/no not have children and who are/are not married</i></p>	<p>LGBTQ+ documentary of transgender. <i>Following from last lesson, students are to watch a documentary on a sexual transition</i></p>
